#### HONORS AND PRIZES

SENIOR HONORS: A book prize established by the Faculty in recognition of those who have the highest standing in scholarship for four years.

LOIS CAROLYN BLACK CYNTHIA HARRIET PEIZER ANNA MARIA CHOTKOWSKI EVE HERZLINGER

THE E. STEVENS HENRY SCHOLARSHIP: Established by the bequest of the late Hon. E. Stevens Henry, for many years a trustee of the University. The income is awarded annually to the Sophomore who had the highest scholastic rank as a Freshman.

CECILIA ANNA NAROWSKI, of the class of 1948

THE BORDEN AGRICULTURAL SCHOLARSHIP AWARD: A cash award to the Senior in the College of Agriculture who has the highest average grade of all similarly eligible students in the first three years of work and who has taken two or more dairy courses.

VICTOR FRANK GALGOWSKI, of the class of 1946

THE BORDEN SCHOLARSHIP IN HOME ECONOMICS: A cash award to the senior in the School of Home Economics who has had two college courses in foods and nutrition and who has the highest scholastic average at the end of the junior year.

LOIS CAROLYN BLACK, of the class of 1946

THE WILLIAM DURAN HOLMAN PRIZE IN ANIMAL HUSBANDRY: Founded by bequest in memory of William Duran Holman, for many years treasurer of the University. Income awarded annually to the Senior and the Junior having the highest standing in Animal Husbandry.

NATHAN STRONG HALE, of the class of 1946 ROBERT BIDWELL BRUCE, of the class of 1947

THE LEHN AND FINK MEDAL: A gold medal, properly inscribed, awarded each year to the member of the graduating class in the College of Pharmacy who has the highest general average for four years.

DAVID MAX GALINSKY, of the class of 1946

THE GARVIN MEMORIAL PRIZE: A cash prize given by the Connecticut Pharmaceutical Association, and awarded to the member of the graduating class in the College of Pharmacy who has shown the greatest progress since his freshman year.

JEROME STANLEY GOLDENBERG, of the class of 1946

THE PHARMACY COMMISSION PRIZE: A cash prize given by the State Pharmacy Commission, and awarded to a member of the graduating class in the College of Pharmacy for excellence in Practical Pharmacy.

DAVID MAX GALINSKY, of the class of 1946

THE BIOCHEMISTRY PRIZE: A cash prize given by a pharmacist of New Haven and awarded for excellence in Biochemistry.

JEROME STANLEY GOLDENBERG, of the class of 1946

MERCK PRIZES: Two sets of three books each given by Merck and Company and awarded to students who stand high in Pharmaceutical Chemistry and Pharmacology.


